HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND INFORMATION LETTER – FALL 2015

Highland High School Marching Band Members & Parents:

Welcome to the Highland Band Program. You are now involved in a family that continually strives to exceed high standards and expectations in everything we are a part of. PLEASE – make sure your information in Charms is updated. Most of the information will be sent out and available through Charms.

Students in marching band will be signed up for the 8th hour marching band class. All attendance policies, grading policies, and classroom rules are in effect as a regular class. Regular rehearsal attendance is required for you to get credit for the class. If you miss too many, you will be dropped from Marching Band just like a normal class. **Required classroom rehearsal times are**:

This year's marching show is called "Portraits of Arizona" We are excited to perform this arrangement of music on the field. Our fall marching schedule is attached. All dates and times, for the most part are accurate. These are all the performances and rehearsals that your student is required to attend. We try to get all the information as accurate as possible, however, please be aware that some changes may still occur.

Please note the 2015 marching band schedule and mark these dates on your family's calendar. Just like school sport games and activities; marching band competitions and festivals do not follow the Gilbert school calendar as these events are scheduled with many other school districts in mind. Please note that we try to schedule around the district calendar, but in some cases that is not possible.

It is very important that students are at every marching band rehearsal. We have to coordinate teaching thousands of drill spots with music and body integration. When your student is not there, it effects everyone in the marching band. If for some reason a student is going to be absent or tardy, it is required that a parent/guardian excuses them through the attendance office and email a director with the reason for missing the rehearsal. Please refer to the attached grading policy on how grades will be given in marching band.

What are acceptable excuses for missing a marching band rehearsal? – Bleeding, Vomiting, Broken Bone(s), High Fever – Not feeling well, a little tummy ache, tired, hungry, whining, birthdays, too much homework, etc... are not valid excuses for missing a rehearsal.

What are acceptable excuses for missing a marching band competition?

- Wedding of immediate family member, Death in the family -

Family vacations, birthday parties, concert tickets you got for your birthday, sporting events, etc... are not valid excuses for missing a competition. There are too many students and parents putting time in to help make the band successful. When your student is not there, the band loses points.

Marching band camp is mandatory. The complete opener music and drill are learned this week as well as all of the warm-ups and pep band songs.

Make sure you dress properly for band camp and bring any necessary items. Students <u>must</u> follow school dress code while in rehearsals. I recommend shorts and a normal/sport unaltered t-shirt, hat, sunscreen, water, and snacks. <u>Good quality running shoes that have laces to tie are required.</u> No flip flops, sandals, Vans, casual shoes, or unlaced shoes will be allowed at rehearsals. <u>Proper marching technique can only be learned with the proper foot-wear.</u>

Parents and students must sign and return the attached participation agreement acknowledging they understand the commitment and financial responsibilities associated with the Highland High School Marching Band.

Please note: Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA or better and must not have a failing grade in any class in order to participate in competitions and festivals. Any student who has these deficiencies at the end of the current spring semester will be placed on the alternate list. Any student who acquires these deficiencies during the season will be withheld from field trips and competitions per Gilbert School Policy. Please note! - You are responsible for all of the fees associated with the marching band even if your student becomes ineligible and is not able to participate in field trips and competitions. Please make sure to check the online grading program on a regular basis to keep track of your child's grades - especially during the first quarter!

I know this is a lot of new information for the students and parents.

As a reminder, we are working with over 500 students and that many more parents on a daily basis. If you do not get a response back from me in 48 hours, please e-mail me again. (Yes, bug me!) I do not intentionally forget, but messages and emails do get buried very quickly from the volume of incoming information during the school year.

Marching Band Fee Payment Schedule

Band Payments are Non-Refundable

Due to the nature of having to pay for music arranging, drill writing, staffing, uniform costs, and so forth up front; if a student needs to quit or leave the band program, any money paid in band fees will not be refunded. State law also prohibits refunding any payments, fund-raising or tax credit money given to the band program. Running a band program is based on the number of participants.

HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT DUE: ASAP

We understand that:

- We are committed to attend and participate in every rehearsal and performance. We have put all of the marching band competitions and rehearsals on our family's calendar and have communicated any concerns to the band director.
- We are aware that there will be marching band fees and will pay them on or before established due dates. (Please make sure to utilize the Arizona Tax Credit System when paying fees. Contact the band boosters for more information.) (Band director <u>must be notified</u> in cases of hardship.) Failure to pay your marching band fees may result in the student being removed from marching band and/or removal from attending marching band field trips/festivals/competitions.
- We have updated the student's contact information in Charms and have included at least one parent and their contact information. Information will be sent out electronically through Charms this year so please make sure to list your e-mail address is accurately.
- > We are expected to maintain uniforms issued to the student and will be financially responsible for any damage or loss.
- > We are expected to maintain instruments/equipment issued and will be financially responsible for any damage or loss.
- We are expected to abide by all rules and policies of the Gilbert Unified School District #41, Highland High School, and the Highland High School Performing Arts Department.
- The commitment to the marching band starts now. From this point we are designing a marching band show with you included. There are no alternates and everyone contributes to or prevents the marching band from being successful. It is very important for you to understand that you have to make marching band a priority in your life and your family's life. When one or two students are not at rehearsals or performances it make the other 100+ students job more difficult and we will lose points by you not being there.
- Members of the marching band are required to maintain good character by being respectful to adults, teachers, and their peers, working hard in school and in band, "Choosing To Do It Right Always." How they treat each other, the equipment, and the facility. We have to take of each other and what we have. Do not take what you have for granted ever.
- We are expected to keep our academic grades current and at a satisfactory level in order to fully participate in marching band. All students must be eligible by the first quarter grading period in order to participate in festivals and competitions per Gilbert Public School's No Pass-No Play Policy. To be eligible, a student must have no F's or I's and must have a GPA above a 2.0 grade point average. Marching band members who are ineligible at the end of this school year may be asked not to participate in marching band due to the fact they need to do their homework and pass school first. Those students who become ineligible at the first grading period will be required to still attend all rehearsals and pay any and all fees associated with the marching band even though they will not be able to compete with the marching band for the rest of the season.
