Your kids have done a great job on so many things this season. We have witnessed an amazing turn-around in behavior and attitude from years past. WE APPRECIATE THIS!



A great Letter from a fellow band parent!

Dear Band Family, Thursday, October 22, 2014

By now you've heard that the band's Fall Tour to California has been canceled. You've also probably heard that there are silver linings in the clouds, Pollyanna makes the best of everything and that lemons make some pretty darn good lemonade. I think that's what we are seeing here.

News of the cancelation reached me at about noon on Tuesday. I was shocked and saddened. The kids were going to be devastated, I was sure. Frantically, I began calling and texting, trying to find out what happened and how I might be of assistance in getting it back. However, by 9:40pm, I had completely changed my tune. At 7:45pm I had come out to the football stadium to watch the band under the lights. I saw a calm, focused group of musicians that looked remarkably less shaken than I expected them to be. They could have been negative and disagreeable, but they weren't. And as the night progressed, they only got better. Corrections were being made quickly, the students' attitudes were positive and they sounded...magical. It was like the Whos down in Who-ville singing contentedly without their gifts. The truth is...this group is finding the gifts we all really want for them...Commitment, determination, focus, unity, wisdom, priorities, musicianship and heart. All the things that make Disneyland pale in comparison.
